<b>Scope of Practice</b>	<p>A Chief Inspector may, where they consider it appropriate, require a registered contractor to certify their work through a representative appointed by the Chief Inspector.</p> <p>An Electrical Contractor Representative may:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(a) certify work within the scope of their registration certificate;</li> <li>(b) only represent one registered contractor at a time unless approval to do so has been granted by the Chief Inspector.</li> </ul> <p>Designated Electrical Contractors who have been assigned an Electrical Contractor Representative are authorized to certify all of portions of their electrical installations, subject to audit by the Government Service Centre.</p>
<b>Ability of Licencee to understand local jurisprudence</b>	N/A
<b>Role or Duties of Licencee related to public safety</b>	Inspect & certify electrical work to verify compliance with Electrical Codes and Standards
<b>Role or Duties of Licencee related to worker safety</b>	Ensure all work is performed by personnel who have been trained and certified by a recognized authority.
<b>Role or Duties of Licencee related to consumer protection</b>	N/A
<b>Requirements to Obtain Licence</b>	<p>A person is eligible for appointment as a representative if the person</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(a) holds an electrical certificate</li> <li>(b) is an employee of a registered contractor; and</li> <li>(c) has at least 4 years of experience in electrical work relevant to his or her electrical certificate; or</li> <li>(d) holds a degree in Electrical engineering and is in good standing with the Association of Professional Engineers and Geoscientists for the province and has at least 2 years experience related to electrical work and who certifies that they consider themselves competent to represent fully and properly a registered contractor.</li> </ul>
